

Side Tilt Carriages

There are actually 4 sizings of hook type fork carriages rated by the fork carriage lifting capability. Hook type blade carriages have been the same.

The carriage bar spacing utilized for Class 1 is roughly thirteen inches and the Class 1 carriage is rated to hold cargo up to 2000lbs. The Class 2 carriage is rated to hold cargo up to 5,500lbs with carriage bar spacing of sixteen inches. Class III carriages are rated for cargo up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this class is twenty inches. Class IV carriages are rated for cargo up to 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this capacity is 25 inches.

The carriages for pin type tines may be different depending on the manufacturer. Pin mounted tines may differ by the amount of offset between the blade eye and the tine. Carriage capacity will be determined by the carriage pin size and by the blade size.
